Dear Parents/Carers,

After nearly 4 weeks back in school, I am delighted with the way the school has settled across the main site and all satellites. We are well underway in delivering the new priorities on the School Improvement Plan. With that in mind, I thought it useful to give you a few updates:

- Community Focussed Schools – I am delighted to inform you that following an interview, Hannah Richards was appointed to the position of Community Focussed Schools officer. As part of this role, Hannah will be working to enhance our links with the local community. Working closely with Donna Pugh, Hannah will be organising a series of whole school parent engagement events in the very near future.
- Therapeutic Art – I’m also delighted to inform you that Hayley John has been appointed to the N-Gage team to lead on therapeutic arts. I am really excited to see how this provision develops over time.
- N-Gage – I have attached the N-Gage information leaflet for parents which is led by Hannah Pearse. N-Gage is our suite of interventions which are delivered on a whole school basis and on an individual basis where provision is linked to IDP/individual need.
- Hydrotherapy – I am so pleased to inform you that the hydrotherapy pool has now reopened and the first couple of classes have enjoyed their sessions. The hydrotherapy pool will not be accessed by all classes.
- Sports Days – I thought these were wonderful occasions. Thank you to all parents/carers for your amazing support. We have 2 more to go next week!

Transport Arrangements

A polite reminder to those parents who drop off and collect their children to and from school that the entire school car park is now functional for this purpose. This means we are trying to run 2 slots for pickups and drop offs:

- Slot 1 - 08:45 - 09:00 & 14:55 - 15:10
- Slot 2 - 09:00 - 09:15 & 15:10 - 15:25 (much quieter slot)

It would be appreciated if parents who drop/collect their children to/from school could do so in one of the time slots above AND park inside the school gates. This will involve joining the queue and not overtaking the line which forms. This is to ensure that the surrounding roads are as free from hazardous parking as possible which is currently attracting complaints.
