Dear parents/carers,

I trust this letter finds you and your family well after the first couple of weeks back in school. Pupils have settled back into school really well and it's been great to see and celebrate their achievements. I write with some important and hopefully useful information.

Building Work

The roof replacement programme will now enter phase 3 (of 5 phases). This will affect Tulip, Willow, Larch, Cherry, Sunflower, Elm and Hawthorn classes. Staff have been working really hard to ensure pupils are supported during this change. I have to say that pupils' have been fantastic once again. This phase will be completed on 10th November 2025.

This phase will also mean that the main school hall is out of action until January. Lunches will be served in classrooms and we have been working with catering to ensure this process is efficient and effective. I am delighted to inform you that we have had a brand new main school kitchen installed over the summer which looks wonderful.

Immunisations Programme

As we head into the Autumn and Winter, it is important to share some updated information in relation to seasonal viruses. Various immunisations will shortly be undertaken in school as usual for a range of seasonal infections.
