This form will be sent annually at the start of each school year. However, please contact the school office at any time should you wish to withdraw consent.

Please be aware that if you take your own photos at a school concert or at sports day they are not covered by data protection law. However, you should be cautious about publishing photos containing images of other pupils (e.g. on social media) for child protection reasons.
