About becoming more independent and having your voice "heard".

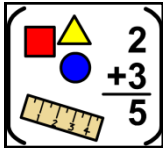




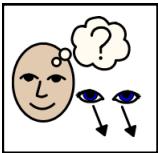

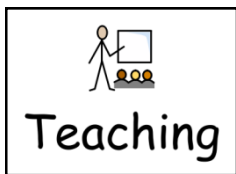


We will make sure that you have lots of different opportunities to practise these skills.

Our staff are highly trained and work together as a great team.



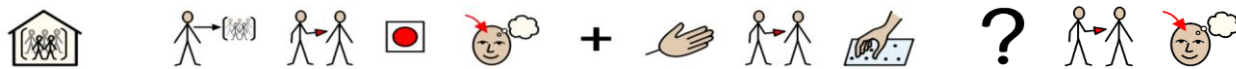

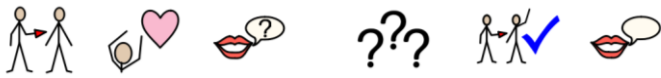
